





WHAT ARE THE SOCIAL SCIENCES?

• What is a social science?

 Social science refers to the <u>academic disciplines</u> concerned with society and human nature

ANTHROPOLOGY

 Is the study of human beings as a species and as members of different cultures

Two major branches of Anthropology are:

Physical Anthropology

- looks at the ways in which humans are similar to, and different from, other species
- How humans have developed biologically over time

ANTHROPOLOGY

Cultural Anthropology

 Explores how culture shaped the way people lived in the past and how they live in the world today

(ex....structures of family, how children are raised from one culture to another)

PSYCHOLOGY

WHAT IS PSYCHOLOGY?

 Psychology is the study of human mental processes and behavior.

 Theoretical Psychologists try to understand general rules that guide our thinking and behavior

They examine overt actions and mental processes

WHAT IS PSYCHOLOGY?

 Clinical Psychologists use this understanding to study emotions such as anger, depression, or anxiety

WHAT IS SOCIOLOGY?

Sociology is the scientific study of people in groups.

 Examines the relationship between people and the social structures they develop

 Sociologist studies the actions and responses of individuals within a group in order to detect general patterns of human behaviour

WHAT IS SOCIOLOGY?

 Sociologists also try to understand how society as a whole can influence our thoughts, feelings and actions
